# **Mission-Based Programs and Activities**

- **Public Policy Program** Meets 1st Thursday at 7:00pm. Informs the membership about pending legislation relevant to AAUW equity focus and guides the branch in effective participation in education, economic security and civil rights. Priorities are *gender and pay equity, Title IX protection*, especially with regard to campus sexual violence and *affordable health care* including reproductive health care.
- Informational Programs of speakers and topical discussions. Have included in the past: Film and Discussion: Rape on the Night Shift; Road to Financial Fitness, California Propositions on the Ballots, Be informed to Disrupt Human Trafficking, Eating Locally, Removing Plastic from Your Life, Gender Identity and Sexual Orientation and Sisters in Crime (local crime fiction authors). In addition, informal Saturday morning gatherings for 'Coffee and Conversation' are scheduled on the last Saturday of most months.
  - **Leadership Opportunities**. Our branch is managed by dedicated volunteer members who serve on the Board of Directors and on committees such as Program Development, Membership, and Public Policy. There is no financial commitment to serve.
  - AAUW FUND and LEGAL ADVOCACY Local and national initiatives educate the branch and the community about fellowships, grants, and special programs, participate in community/campus outreach initiatives, support workplace sex discrimination cases, and much more. Social fundraising events and member donations support these programs.

## **Community Action Projects**

Through *Community Action Projects* (CAPs) San Jose branch members have the opportunity to participate in ongoing projects that serve our local community and promote gender and educational equity.

#### **Gifts for Teens**

Assembles and distributes festive holiday gift totes and sports bags to San Jose teenagers in need.

#### **Local Scholarship**

Awards scholarships to women seeking a 4-year college degree to help women in their pursuit of higher education.

### **Neighbors Helping Neighbors**

Meets First Monday at 7:00 pm. Collaborates with local agencies to provide hands-on help for action.

#### **Tech Trek**

A week-long math and science camp for 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls sponsored by AAUW California and held at 8 different colleges in the summer.
