American Association of University Women – San Jose scholarships are awarded annually to women who have a permanent home address in Campbell, Milpitas, San Jose, or Santa Clara, California, who have completed two full years of an accredited college or university, who have a minimum 3.0 GPA, and who are enrolled in a four-year institution as an undergraduate. Awards are based on the strength of the application and an interview with the Local Scholarship Committee.

April 15 Deadline. **Application and all supporting documents must be received by April 15 11:59 PM.** PDT or postmarked by April 15. This deadline is firm. No application considered after April 15 2023.

In addition, please share how you exemplify any of the themes in our mission statement: a) supporting equity and education for women and girls, b) advocating for societal change, c) connecting with your community, or d) excelling academically and leading by example.
- b. Please email the application with above essay to scholarships@aauwsanjose.org or mail to Local Scholarship, AAUW San Jose Branch, 1165 Minnesota Ave., Suite 100, San Jose, CA 95125-3324, dated or postmarked no later than 11:59 PM PT on April 15.**
- c. Provide an official transcript from all colleges or universities attended.
- d. Provide a written recommendation from one college instructor or college counselor.
- e. Have transcripts and recommendations mailed directly to Local Scholarship, AAUW San Jose Branch, 1165 Minnesota Ave., Suite 100, San Jose, CA 95125-3324, or send as a Word or PDF file attachment to scholarships@aauwsanjose.org, dated or postmarked no later than 11:59 PM PT on April 15.

You will be notified by email confirmation once your complete application has been received. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure all parts of the application are delivered by April 15. You will be notified by email again if you are selected for an interview. The awards will be made by the end of May 2023. AAUW San Jose shall appropriately recognize you in key internal and external publications, and on social media.
